



Year 6 Homework Expectations

- 1.1 In Year Six, we scale back on the use of the online tools, preferring to help children with both the levels and types of homework they might experience at secondary school.
- 1.2 Homework (often in worksheet form, but sometimes along the lines of the Learning Platform (online) approaches they will see in Year 7), is set weekly, and will often take longer than in previous years. It will consist of a piece of maths and a piece of literacy each week. Spellings are worked on at least three times a week in class (and tested periodically), and times tables may form a significant part of some maths lessons.
- 1.3 Homework is marked and returned the same week it is set, team points are awarded, and the work is filed for children to take home at a later date.
- 1.4 The online tools are still set up for revision work, and for children who have still not mastered their spellings or times tables.
