Year 3	<p>Unit 1 Rainforests</p> <p>From the layers of the forest and its animal inhabitants, to the unique climate found in the tropics, in this Unit, children take a closer look at the mysteries of tropical rainforests.</p>	<p>Unit 2 The UK</p> <p>Children will take a look at the geography of the UK - from the physical features of mountains, rivers and seas to the man-made administrative regions and counties.</p>			<p>Unit 3 All Around the World</p> <p>Children will learn to locate and describe places using longitude and latitude, and find out about some of the important lines that delineate specific areas of the Earth.</p>
