Pupils to explore the ways that different people and different faiths celebrate New Year.	Unit 4 How should the church celebrate Easter? Pupils to explore how and why the church celebrates Easter.	Unit 5 Can stories change people? Pupils to explore Old Testament and New Testament stories.	Unit 6 How should you spend the weekend? Pupils to explore the practice of observing Shabbat and the implications for Jewish believers and children.
Year 3	Unit 1 Does taking communion show that someone is a Christian? Pupils to explore the ritual of communion and other ways of belonging to the church.	Unit 2 Is Light a good symbol for a celebration? Pupils to understand the significance of light as a symbol of belief.	Unit 3 Is a Hindu child free to choose how to live? Pupils to learn about Hindu beliefs including the 5 daily duties and family life and worship.	Unit 4 Does Easter make sense without Passover? Pupils to explore the connections between Passover and Easter, particularly the Last Supper.	Unit 5 Does Jesus have authority for everyone? Pupils to explore the life and teachings of Jesus and to examine the authority that Jesus has for Christians today.	Unit 6 Can made up stories tell the truth? Pupils to explore how Jesus taught truths through story and why he chose to do this.
Year 4	Unit 1 Do Murtis help Hindus to understand God? Pupils to explore how Hindus express their beliefs through images of deities and symbols.	Unit 2 Does the Christmas narrative need Mary? Pupils to explore the role of Mary in Christian life and in the Christmas story in particular.	Unit 3 Is a holy journey necessary for believers? Pupils to explore the holy journeys made by believers; the reasons and impact for such journeys.	Unit 4 Should believers give things up? Pupils to explore Lent and its significance for Christian belief and practice.	Unit 5 Did Jesus really perform miracles? Pupils to explore at least two miracles of Jesus and evaluate them from the view of a believer and a sceptic.	Unit 6 Does prayer change things? Pupils to explore the reasons why believers pray and what they believe the results are.
Year 5	Unit 1 Do Sikhs need the Guru Granth Sahib? Pupils to explore different ways of showing belief with special reference to Sikhism.	Unit 2 Do Muslims need the Qur'an? Pupils to explore different ways of showing belief with special reference to Islam.	Unit 3 Does the community of the Mosque help Muslims lead better lives? Pupils to explore how the Mosque is viewed and how it influences the life and belief of Muslims.	Unit 4 Christianity: Was the death of Jesus a worthwhile sacrifice? Pupils to explore the significance of death of Jesus at Easter for Christians.	Unit 5 Are you inspired? Pupils to explore the Holy Spirit and find out what inspires Christians in the past and today.	Unit 6 What is best for our world? Does religion help people decide? Pupils to explore how and why believers help others through charity and service.
Year 6	Unit 1 Are saints encouraging role models? Pupils to compare the saints to the person and persecution of Jesus.	Unit 2 Is "God made man" a good way to understand the Christmas story? Pupils to explore the concept of incarnation in the Christmas story, to compare the Biblical narrative with a traditional Christmas story.	Unit 3 Do clothes express beliefs? Pupils to explore whether clothing rules and restrictions express belief and give a sense of identity.	Unit 4 Is the resurrection important to Christians? Pupils to explore the resurrection of Jesus, the Easter narrative and concepts of life after death.	Unit 5 Can we know what God is like? Pupils to explore different views of God and how some people believe they can know God or know about God and why some do not believe at all	Unit 6 Does it matter what we believe about creation? Pupils to explore different views of creation and consider the consequences of holding certain beliefs.
