

Sonning Common Primary School After School Club (ASC)

At the After School Club we aim:

- to provide a safe, comfortable and happy environment for children who attend Sonning Common Primary School.
- to allow parents and carers more flexibility in their work, education and family commitments. Our staff includes NVQ3 trained child carers who hold first aid and epipen certificates. Although we do have some on-going arts and crafts projects, the children are free to use their time with us as they wish, playing with a large selection of toys and games, including outside activities when the weather allows.

Tea Time Menu

Kites Kitchen is fully involved in preparing the after school club menu and all menus are carefully planned to integrate and comply with government standards across the whole school day.

The menu varies from day to day, the choices include: Pasta bake, curries, pies, paninis, tortilla wraps, hot dogs and rolls with various fillings. On Fridays, children make their own pizzas. Alternatives are always available along with cucumber, carrot and pepper sticks and a selection of fruit every day.

Time: 3:20 – 6.00pm every term time afternoon. The children meet in the school hall at 3.20pm. In the case of new Kites, the staff will collect the children from their classrooms.

Cost: £4 until 4pm, or £13 until 6pm.

Bookings can be made through MCAS (My Child at School). You can book individual sessions for one of more children, or book up to one term ahead, and you can pay for these sessions online using the secure payment system or using your Childcare vouchers.
