## School dinners and wraparound care

New prices from September 2024 will be:

- Key Stage 2 dinners will be £2.60 per meal
- Breakfast Club will be £6 per session including a choice of breakfast options
- Afterschool Club (4pm pickup) will be £4.50 per session
- Afterschool Club (6pm pickup) will be £14 including a substantial meal

We still believe that we offer families outstanding value. We will retain our flexible booking policies ensuring our wrapround care remains accessible and our NVQ3 trained staff will continue to provide a diverse range of activities for children.
