New prices from September 2024 will be:

- Key Stage 2 dinners will be £2.60 per meal
- Breakfast Club will be £6 per session including a choice of breakfast options
- Afterschool Club (4pm pickup) will be £4.50 per session
- Afterschool Club (6pm pickup) will be £14 including a substantial meal
