Playdough Pot Plant Pots

You will need:

- Empty playdough pot with its lid
- Washi tape in different colours/patterns
- Scissors
- Soil
- Small plant or seeds
- Small screwdriver



1. Make sure your playdough pot is clean and dry, and remove any labels.
2. Choose the washi tape you want to use.
3. Decorate your pots with the washi tape however you want. Have fun mixing and matching colours and patterns! Remember to be careful when using scissors to cut the tape.
4. You'll need a grown-up to do this next part. Carefully, push the screwdriver through the bottom of the pot several times to make some holes. The holes will help the water to drain away.
5. Fill your playdough pots about halfway with soil.
6. Put your plant or seeds into the soil.
7. Fill the rest of the pot with soil.
8. Put the lid underneath the pot. This will help to collect any water drips.
9. Don't forget to water your plant and give it plenty of sunlight!
