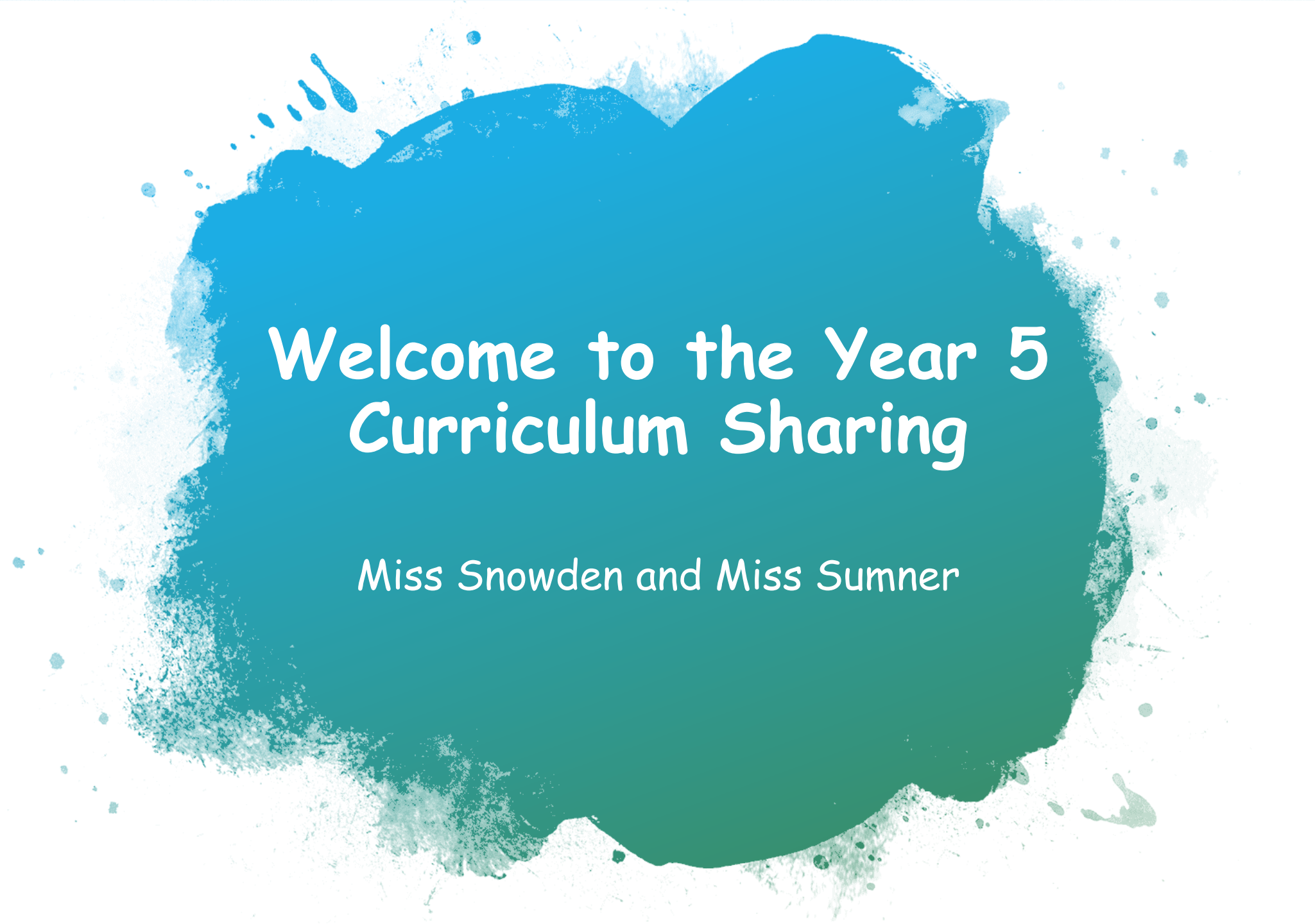

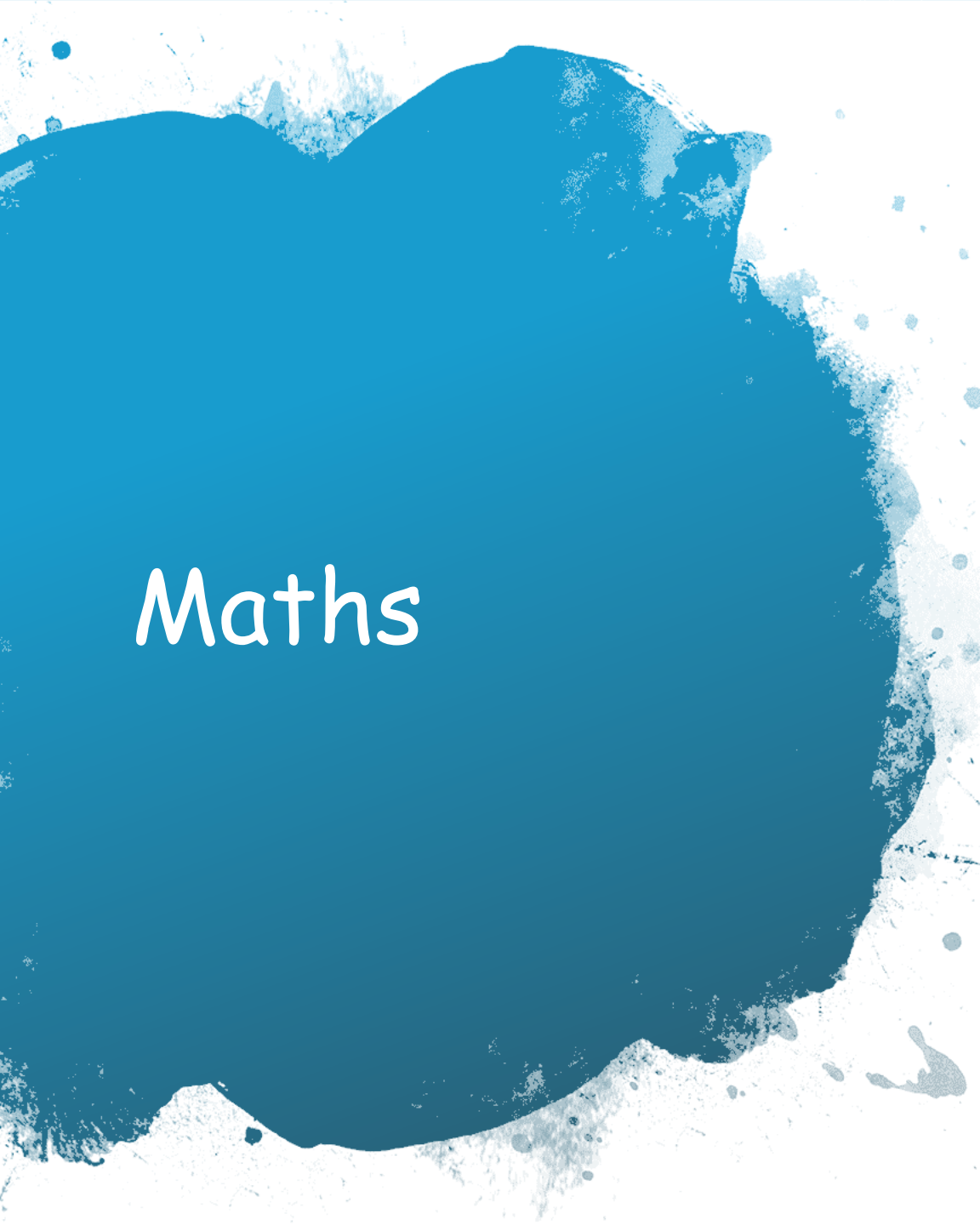

- The teaching assistant will respond to/check this once a week.

- Signed and read 4 times = 1 team point

Your child/children will need to come in their PE kit every Monday and Friday.



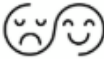
Library

- Appropriate kit

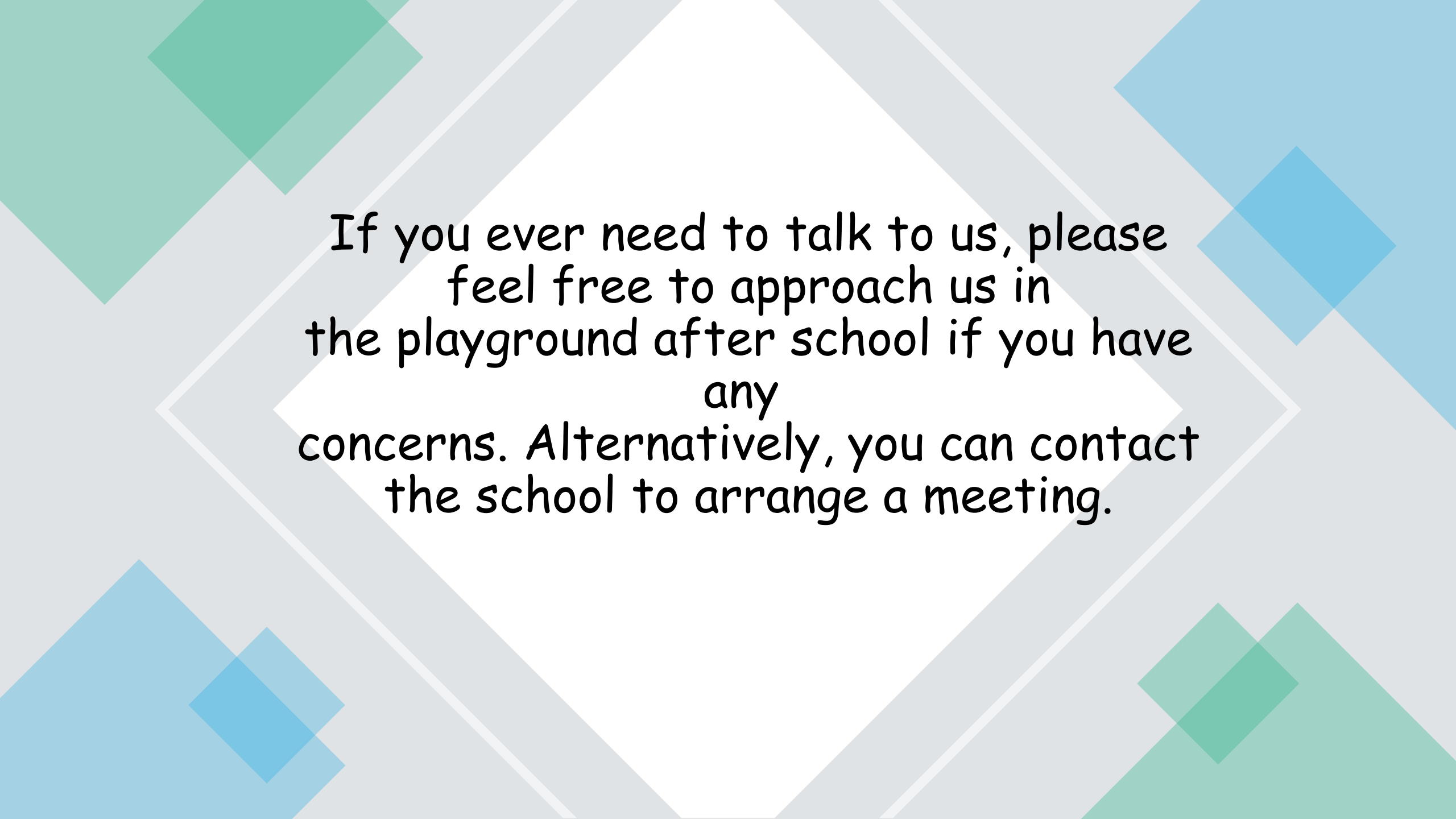
