






National Curriculum

A minimum of 10 minutes for both each week





• In year 4, children will cover genres such as poetry, story writing, drama, stories with historical settings, narrative verse, playscripts and cultural tales.



- Fill in reading record 4 times a week and signed by an adult
- Checked every Thursday morning
- It is school policy that if the planner is not handed in, or they haven't read AT LEAST four times that week, then children will miss their playtime. Please support your child by reading with them as much as possible
- If your child has read 4 times and their planner is signed, they will go to playtime as normal and get team points
- Planners are due in every Thursday, which is the same as the literacy and maths homework

Vikings


- Anglo Saxons and their battles with the Vikings, religion, food, weapons
