Reading

Children are expected to read four times a week.

This can be their school reading books, phonics book, or a book from home.

Maths

We follow White Rose **Maths** using the **Mastery Approach** to teaching maths

Please ask if you are unsure about different methods and we would be happy to show you.

The main way you can support it to help children to learn their times tables and help make maths real! E.g. Count in 2s at the supermarket, allowing your child to handle money, cooking, measuring, telling the time etc.

P.E. and Games

Please ensure children come into school in their PE kits on PE days. This will make transitions easier and ensure optimum learning time!



Indoor PE is on a Friday.



Outdoor PE is on a Thursday.



The children will need jogging bottoms and a school hoodie during the colder months.

Forest Camp and Swimming

Swimming kits will be sent home the day they are used. We will keep forest camp kits until they need washing!



Forest camp is every other term on a Thursday. Mrs Skidmore and Mrs Hogan's class will be going in term 1 and Miss Stone's in term 2.



We have put a timetable in the window so you can check what term your child has forest camp and swimming.



Miss Stone's class will be swimming in term 1. Mrs Skidmore and Mrs Hogan's class will swim in term 2. Swimming day is Tuesday.

SATs

Are no longer statutory but we will complete assessments for our own judgements.

The children will sit maths, reading, spelling and SPAG papers.

The children think they are completing 'special tasks' or a quiz.

Helping at Home

Read	-Read with your child as often as you can. Question them about the books they are reading- link to other books, real experiences etc.
Sign	-Sign their Reading Records.
Tables	-Work on their times tables (2s, 3s, 5s, 10s),
Allow time	- Allow them time to complete spelling shed and TTRS/Numbots if you have internet access at home

FAQs

What do I do if I want to speak to my child's class teacher?
